Proper folding of the Dress White Jumper

Turn the jumper in-side-out and place it on a firm smooth surface with the arms extended to the sides. Note how the collar is folded along the two outer creases with the two stars showing. Note the pocket is up and visible.



Now, fold the jumper in half along the middle crease. Line up the sleeves. The collar is folded along the middle crease and both the inner and outer creases along the middle of the jumper should be lined up carefully to avoid creating a "double crease"



Fold both sleeves across the chest area of the jumper while insuring the creases are properly aligned. The fold at the shoulder should begin at the shoulder seam just above the NSCC shoulder patch.





Neatly fold the collar down over the folded sleeves and ensure the creases along the collar are properly aligned.





Now fold the trail end of the sleeves back across the collar.





Neatly fold the bottom of the jumper up and make it even with the top. At this point, you should have a nice neat square with no hanging ends. Your jumper is stored in this manner to preserve its creases and to keep it clean.
